The consultant should have possess editing skills both in Bahasa and English languages, good quality printing work and expertise to conduct book road show

Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have adequate staffs who fluent in both English and Bahasa Indonesia in term of speaking and writting to edit the content of the books, translate the books and design the book covers; organize the production of e-book and printing of the book; and organize the book road show. The information should include core business and years in business, relevant experience, and technical and managerial capability of the consulting firm. The shortlisting criteria are prior experiences in working with Indonesian government institutions in producing printed books and e-books, as well as organizing a roadshow will be considered as a strong advantage. The consultant should meet the following requirements as mentioned in Terms of Reference.
