The Asosiasi Auditor Intern Pemerintah Indonesia (“The Association”) has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Strengthening Internal Audit Audit Project and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (“the Services”) include the assignment to enhance Government Internal Auditors capacity to Government Internal Control System (SPIP) implementation which includes (i) obtain data on the Government Internal Control System (SPIP) implementation in Government of Indonesia from both BPKP and selected ministries and local governments; (ii) obtain best practices on Government Internal Control System implementation data from other countries and IIA.; (iii) facilitate discussions on how to improve the current support provided to improve Government Internal Control System (SPIP) implementation (including improvement of PEFA assessment grade); and (iv) documenting the proposal for sharing with bigger audience in the workshop.

The Asosiasi Auditor Intern Pemerintah Indonesia now invites eligible consulting firms (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required experience and competence in facilitating and assisting the Government Internal Auditors’ capacity to support Government Internal Control System (SPIP) implementation. The information should include core business and years in business, relevant experience, and technical and managerial capability of the individual consultant. The shortlisting criteria are expected that experiences consultant in prior experience working with Indonesian government will be considered as strong advantage. The consultant should meet the following requirements as mentioned in Terms of Reference.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants [under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants] by World Bank Borrowers [January 2011, revised July 2014]* (“Consultant Guidelines”), setting forth the World Bank’s policy on conflict of interest.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Selection Based on Consultant’s Qualification (“CQS”) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
